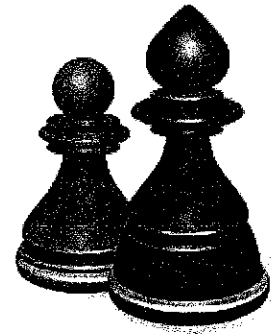

Attention parents!



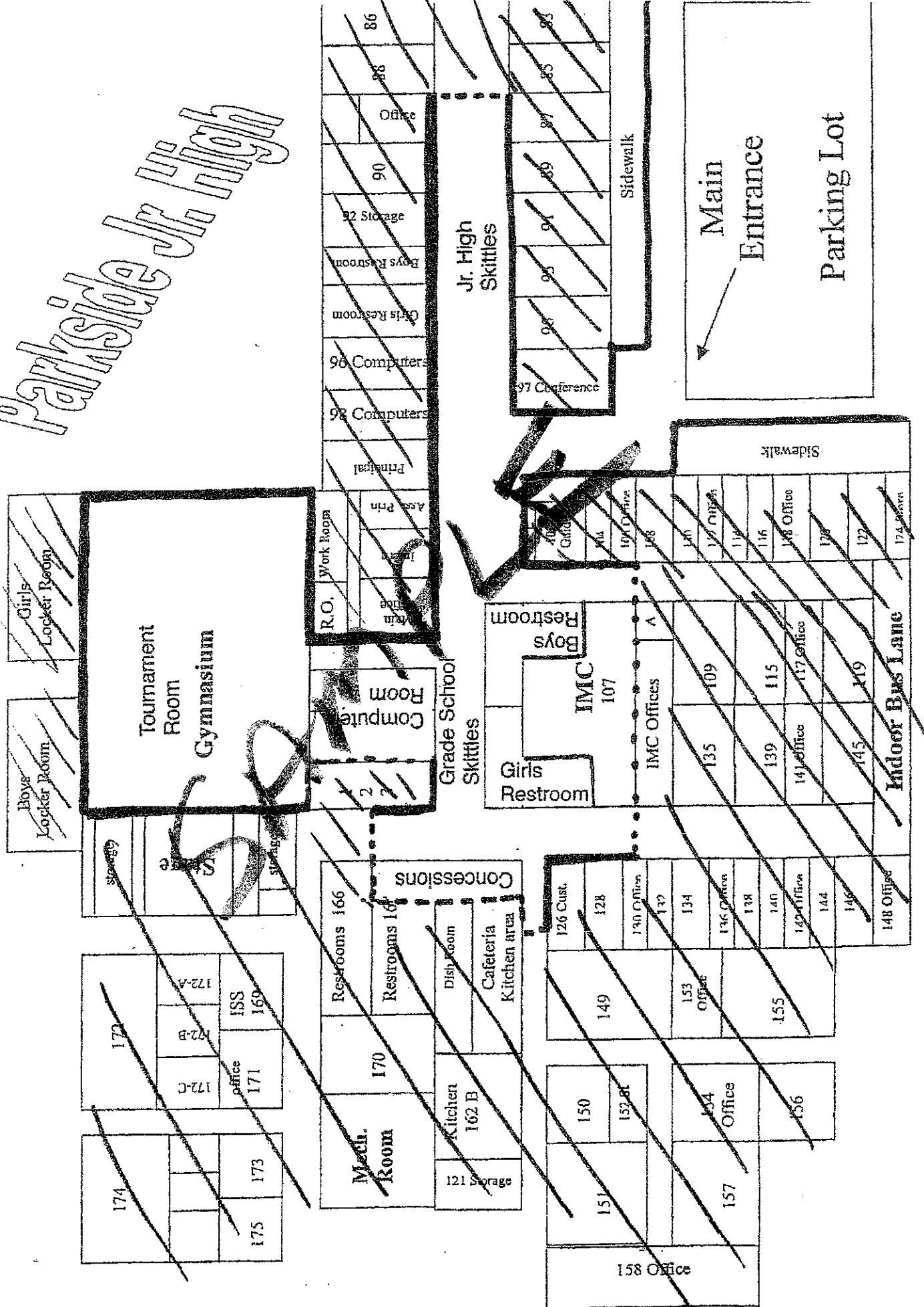
Please attend an informal Q & A session in the Parkside Foyer presented by Scott Daniels. The session will take place after the tournament begins, approximately 9:10 am.

Scott is a local parent that started off with his oldest son playing chess at Grove Elementary when he was in Kindergarten. Over the last six years, as his son has grown in chess, Scott has become a board member of both the Illinois Chess Association (ICA) and Bloomington-Normal Area Scholastic Chess (BNASC) organization. Today, his oldest son, Jason, is a 6th grader at Chiddix, and his middle child, Alex, is a 1st grader at Grove. Over the course of the last six years the family has attended over 100 tournaments and this has provided Scott with an unique view of chess as a parent. Scott can attest that when his oldest son started playing chess he had a big learning curve from understanding the chess world to learning to relax. We hope you can spend a few minutes asking questions and getting a deeper understanding of competitive chess.

Some of the topics Scott will explain include:

- * How tournament pairings work
- * What a rating is and how they are calculated
- * How the tie breaks system works for awards
- * How to handle coaching or training at home
- * Any other competitive chess you may have
- * Also, he will answer any questions about the ICA or BNASC

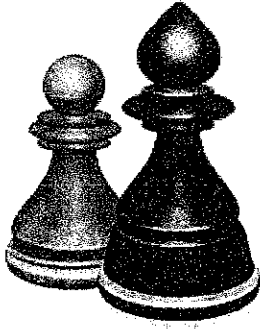

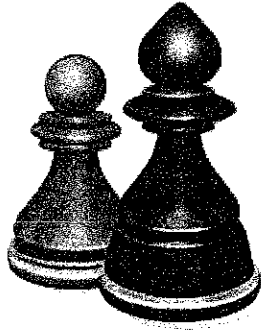

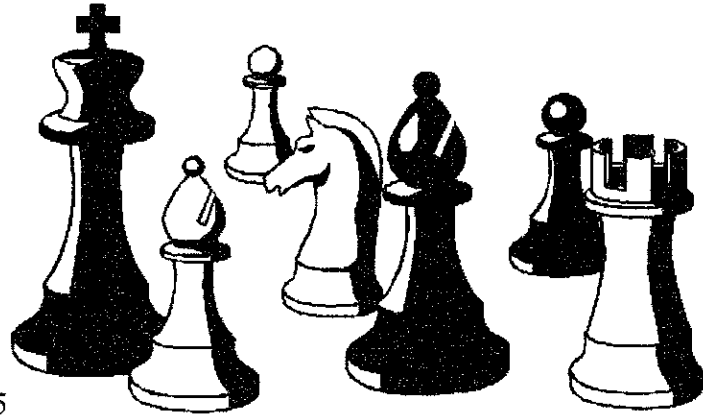
